



The 'Modular Cargo Bay' powered by BOSCH BSTP

The concept of the modular cargo bay is simple, take existing properties and build secure parking spaces into them.

- Fully enclosed steel parking bay
- Vehicle entry and exit controlled by reservation link
- 360-degree CCTV coverage in and outside the bay
- Event triggered remote monitoring
- o 'No-motion' alarmed zone inside the bay
- Fully luminated in and outside the bay
- Reservation only access

ENTERING THE BAY



The driver aligns the truck to the correct bay, ready to reverse the trailer towards the door.

The driver calls their Dispatcher to open the door using the remote email link, found in the booking confirmation.




ENTERING THE BAY

The driver reverses the trailer into the unit and uncouples the trailer from the truck. 4.

Once the trailer is detached, the driver leaves the unit with the truck and waits for the doors to close.



5. GIVING YOUR DRIVERS A BREAK



The driver must not enter the bay at any point during the stay. If the driver needs to regain entry, a new code must be obtained dispatcher by calling the dispatcher.


In the event of a fire, the driver must exit via the fire door. This process is



The driver aligns the truck with the bay, then calls the dispatcher to exit.








Before boarding

Fully retract the front and back landing legs of the trailer.



When boarding

The maximum speed is 10mph.



When parking the trailer in the parking bay

Reverse the trailer into the bay until the back wheels hit the wheel stops. Make sure the front of the trailer does not obstruct the roller door from closing.



Before leaving your vehicle

Please switch off all electrical devices.

How to use the Reservation Platform








1. Find the parking area: https://portal.bosch-secure-truck-parking.com/en/registration/



- ► Open the page https://portal.bosch-secure-truck-parking.com/en/
- Click on the button "Manage" and log in




- ► You can find a parking area in different ways:
 - ► Enter the city in the field "Search"
 - ► Search for the parking area in the map
- Click on the button "Reserve"



2. Enter dates and times







- Enter entre date, time and duration


- ► Create a driver and enter his name, mail address, licence plate etc.

...or select a driver


- Select an existing driver

4. Make a reservation




- You can send a confirmation mail to the driver

- You can also open the confirmation as .pdf




5. Cancel a reservation

Reservation Platform

- 1. LSP makes reservation on BSTP platform.
- 2. LSP responsible for the security of their access codes. They are single use.
- 3. Bosch Monitoring centre receives booking confirmation.
- LSP is responsible for amending all reservation.

Communication Chain

- 1. Upon arrival, truck driver will contact their LSP for access to Bay.
- LSP will use access link from the Bosch booking confirmation to open the gate.
- The driver reverses into the Bay, uncouples the trailer and drives away. This process is overseen by the Bosch monitoring centre.
- In the event an alarm is raised, the Bosch monitoring centre (and only the Bosch monitoring centre) will contact the local police department.
- Should the driver wish to raise their own alarm, they must follow their normal chain of communication with their LSP.
- When returning to the Bay, the driver is to contact their LSP to gain access to the Bay.
- 7. The LSP will use their second access code to open the gate.
- 8. The driver reverses into the Bay, recouples the trailer and drives away. This process is overseen by the Bosch monitoring centre.





FREIGHTSAFE PRICING



FREIGHTSAFE HAS TWO PRICING OPTIONS

1. Daily rate pricing

Customer can book the bays on a day-by-day basis and pay via the Bosch secure truck parking platform. The hourly rate varies from €5-10 per hour of parking.

2. Annual rental pricing

Customer buys their fixed capacity on an annual basis at €60 per day. The customer can sell-on their spare capacity when not using it via the Bosch secure truck parking platform. Any spare capacity sold is shared with Freightsafe and is used to reduce your subsequent year's rental price.

3. Liability swap service

Freightsafe will take the liability of the trailer and it's cargo when it is parked with us.
